The fate of an orphan is as precariously as that of a widow. Orphans are currently snipping petrol or are involved in other criminally



dangerous activities including but not limited to illicit drugs, stealing and all sort of bad dealings which they do not voluntarily involved themselves but are circumstantially forced to make living from.
